About the APAC Food Safety Awards

Category 1: Ross Peters Award for Excellence in Food Safety

This category is intended for any individual who has made a notable contribution to food safety in Australia. This person may be from a company of any size and from any sector.

Eligible nominees must have:

- A visible passion and commitment to driving food safety with evidence to support professional development
- Made a notable contribution to the food industry
- Dedicated themselves to the implementation of food safety initiatives
- Furthered the ideals of a safe food supply

Examples of the above could include: assisting a food and/or agricultural production, or food service business develop and implement their food safety plans to the point where it has assisted an employer and/or client/s in maintaining the safety of their food products. Category 2: Leaders of the Future - Food Safety Learning Scholarship

SAI Global launched the Food Safety Learning Scholarship in 2013 as a way of promoting and supporting highly skilled industry professionals. The Scholarship (a voucher applicable to a select range of SAI Global Assurance Training courses) will provide one individual with the opportunity to register and complete food safety courses to the value of \$10,000 AUD.

Eligible applicants must currently work within the food industry and have a junior quality assurance role or equivalent. The applicant must have a background or experience which shows a unique perspective on food safety, a drive towards continuous improvement and leadership potential through vision.

Category 3: Innovators in Food Safety

This Award recognises an individual or organisation that has developed best in class innovations in technology, process, procedure and training regarding food safety.

The work produced by the winner of this Award will have made a positive and influential impact on food safety in the Asia Pacific region through an innovative idea or product.

Both individuals and organisations are eligible for this Award and they may be from any sector within the agri-food industry, from a company of any size.

Individuals or companies may submit more than one nomination in separate categories. Self-nominations will be accepted and you may also nominate on another person's behalf. All nominees must meet the requirements listed under each category and must be currently working in the food industry. All award winners are expected to attend the 2019 APAC Food Safety Gala Awards Dinner in Sydney, and will be responsible for their own travel and accommodation costs. Previous winners are not eligible. Awards are open to nominees from the Asia Pacific region. For the Category 2: Leaders of the Future - Food Safety Learning Scholarship, all training must be completed by December 2020. Some exclusions apply.
